Something to Think About

Our world is often a very noisy place! Can you think of some noisy, busy places in your life? Sometimes we need a break and we need to find somewhere quiet. Can you think of a place you like to go that is peaceful and quiet?

The Story

Wherever Jesus went, people crowded to see him, listen to him and ask for healing. Jesus needed time to rest and relax and renew his energy. He often went away to a quiet place to pray and rest.

The Scriptures

A reading from the holy gospel according to Mark

6:30-34

After the apostles returned to Jesus, they told him everything they had done and taught. But so many people were coming and going that Jesus and the apostles did not even have a chance to eat.

Then Jesus said, " Let's go to a place where we can be alone and get some rest." They left in a boat for a place where they could be alone. But many people saw them leave and figured out where they were going. So people from every town ran on ahead and got there first.

When Jesus got out of the boat, he saw the large crowd that was like sheep without a shepherd. He felt sorry for the people and started teaching them many things.

Group Activity

MY FAVOURITE QUIET PLACE

You will need: an A3 sheet of white paper for each child, newspaper to cover the tables, paints, palettes or paint pots, a variety of paintbrushes, sponges, water, aprons.

An alternative would be simply to use coloured markers, coloured pencils or crayons for this artwork.

1. Invite the children to think about a quiet place where they like to rest and pray, and then create an artwork of that place.
2. Ask children to write the words "My Quiet Place" somewhere on their artwork. Adults or older children can assist as needed.
