Something to Think About

Many people did not believe in Jesus and some even made fun of him. Has anyone made fun of you? How did you feel? What did you do?

The Story

In this gospel reading we hear about Jesus right at the end of his life on earth. He is hanging on the cross, and some people are making fun of him. They are saying that if Jesus really is God's son, he should just get down off the cross. One of the criminals who was also on a cross beside Jesus makes fun of him too. But the criminal on the other side is different. He knows that Jesus has done nothing wrong, and he believes in Jesus. He asks Jesus to remember him when he comes into his kingdom. Jesus promises the good criminal that he would be together with Jesus in heaven.

The Scriptures

A reading from the holy gospel according to Luke

23:35-43

While the crowd stood there watching Jesus, the leaders insulted him by saying, "He saved others. Now he should save himself, if he really is God's chosen Messiah!"

The soldiers made fun of Jesus and brought him some wine.

They said, "If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself!"

Above him was a sign that said, "This is the King of the Jews."

One of the criminals hanging there also insulted Jesus by saying,

"Aren't you the Messiah? Save yourself and save us!"

But the other criminal told the first one off,

"Don't you fear God? Aren't you getting the same punishment as this man? We got what was coming to us, but he didn't do anything wrong."

Then he said to Jesus,

"Remember me when you come into power!"

Jesus replied,

"I promise that today you will be with me in paradise."

Group Discussion

Jesus promised the 'good thief' that he would enjoy 'paradise'. Invite the children to share their ideas about what 'paradise' might look like. Remind the children that Jesus talked about the kingdom in terms of justice and love and compassion. Could this be what 'paradise' is like?

Leader: Loving God, listen to the prayers we make in the name of Jesus.

All: Amen.

Group Activity


Instructions for Making a Crown

You will need: two-page template, coloured markers, glue, scissors, wool, hole punch, pom-poms (optional)

- 1. Colour the circles.
- 2. Colour the crown.
- 3. Match the picture in the circle to the words on the crown.
