Something to Think About

God has given each of us special abilities and gifts to honour God and serve others. Jesus reminds us that we should do our best with the talents God has given us. Each of us must decide if we are going to use our gifts for God, and how we are going to do that.

When the master returned, he was very happy with the servant for working hard to grow the gift he was given.

A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to Matthew

Jesus told his disciples this story about the kingdom of God:

"The kingdom is like what happened when a man went away and put his three servants in charge of all he owned. The man knew what each servant could do.

So he handed five thousand coins to the first servant, two thousand to the second, and one thousand to the third.

Then he left the country.

"Some time later the master of those servants returned.

He called them in and asked what they had done with his money.

The servant who had been given five thousand coins

brought them in with the five thousand that he had earned.

He said, 'Sir, you gave me five thousand coins,

and I have earned five thousand more.'

"Wonderful!' his master replied, 'You are a good and faithful servant. I left you in charge of only a little, but now I will put you in charge of much more.

You will need: template pages photocopied onto cardboard, colouring pencils, scissors, glue and ribbon.


1) Colour the template pages.


2) Cut around the bag and coins. Glue or staple the scripture verse at the base of the bag leaving the upper side unstuck to form a pocket.

3) Children might like to paste their favourite talents onto the upper part of the bag, or store their coins in the pocket.4) Tie a piece of ribbon around the top of the bag.


